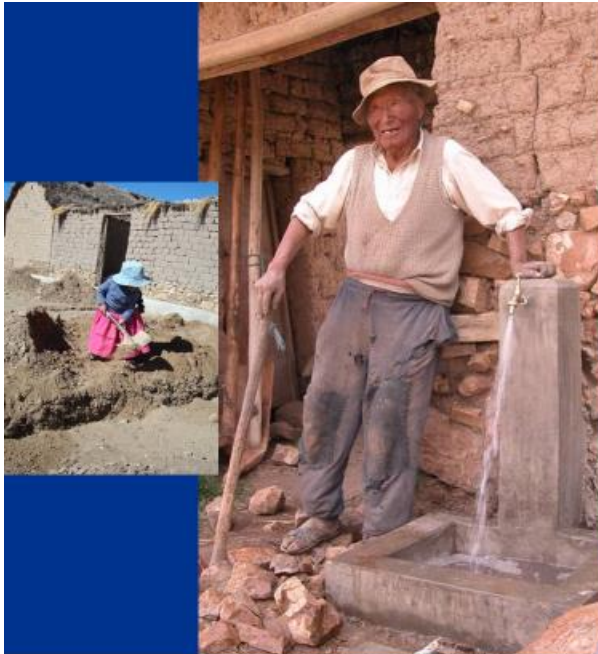

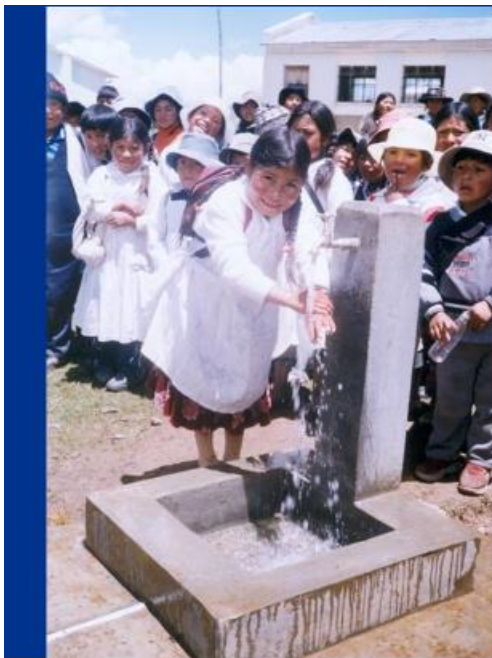


Improving likelihood of success
